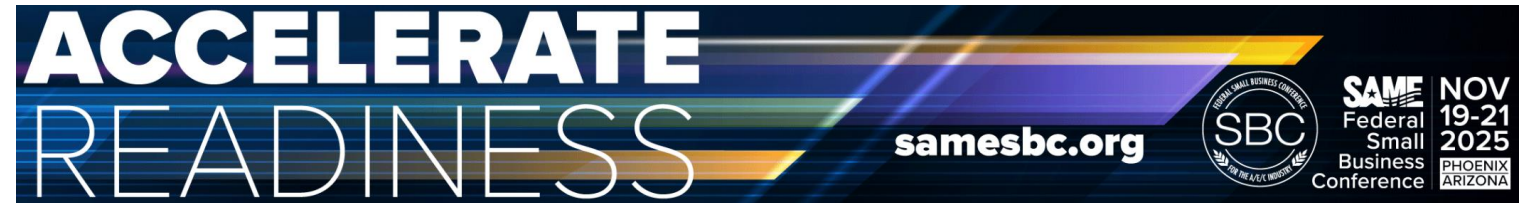

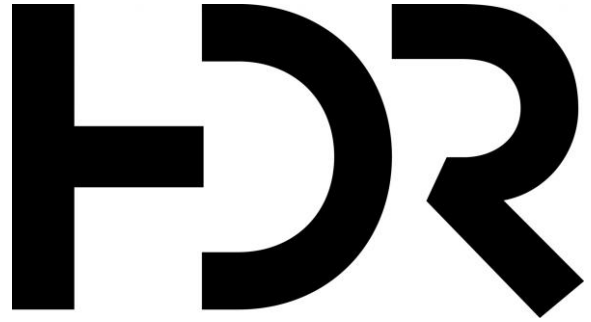
SAME Communities of Interest
